1. Executive Summary

Following an accessibility evaluation conducted over the period 25 April 2026 to 10 June 2026 and the remediation undertaken by the Regulated Entity, <https://equitymidas.com/> conforms to WCAG 2.1 Level AA.

This Final Audit Report states the conformance position reached. The evaluation findings and the remediation record are set out in full in the accompanying Evaluation & Regression Report; the supporting captures are in the Evidence Report.

1.1 Conformance summary

The 41 conforming and the 9 not applicable together account for all 50 Level A and AA Success Criteria. Of the 41 conforming, 14 were remediated during the engagement.

3. Methodology

The evaluation followed the W3C Website Accessibility Conformance Evaluation Methodology (WCAG-EM 1.0). The platform was assessed over the period 25 April 2026 to 10 June 2026, and this report states the conformance position reached following the remediation undertaken by the Regulated Entity. Conformance is asserted at the rendered-DOM level against WCAG 2.1 Level AA.

4. Accompanying Records

The evaluation findings and the remediation record are set out in full in the accompanying Evaluation & Regression Report; the supporting captures are in the Evidence Report. A Certificate of Conformance accompanies this filing.

5. What works

An audit is not only what needs correcting. The platform already meets the Success Criteria below — each one a genuine strength for the people who depend on it.

2.1.2 No Keyboard Trap	Keyboard focus can always move away from a component.
2.4.7 Focus Visible	The keyboard focus indicator is visible.

1.4.4 Resize Text	Text can be enlarged to 200% without loss of content or function.

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6. Conformance Claim

<https://equitymidas.com/> conforms to WCAG 2.1 Level AA.

Basis of the claim:

- Of the 50 Level A and AA Success Criteria, 41 conform and 9 are not applicable to this platform.
- Of the 41 conforming, 14 recorded findings at evaluation that were remediated during the engagement and re-assessed as conforming; the remaining 27 recorded no finding.

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Key Findings and Observations

Companion narrative to the consolidated audit report

Overview

37 pages of <https://equitymidas.com/> were evaluated between 25 April 2026 and 10 June 2026. 14 of the 50 Success Criteria at WCAG 2.1 Levels A and AA recorded findings, resolving to 140 distinct defects.

This narrative explains what was found and who it affects. The consolidated audit report carries the per-criterion matrix and the conformance claim; this document is written to be read rather than consulted.

Who is affected

On the evidence of this evaluation, screen reader users, people with low vision and keyboard-only and switch users cannot complete at least one task on this platform. People with colour vision deficiency and people with cognitive or learning disabilities can complete their tasks, but with materially more effort.

Groups are counted as stopped where a task cannot be completed at all, not merely made harder. The criteria behind each are in the sections that follow.

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Name, Role, Value — SC 4.1.2, Level A

Every control exposes what it is, what it is called, and what state it is in.

What this looks like in practice. An icon-only button announced as just "button", or a toggle that never reports whether it is on.

Who is affected. Screen reader users above all — this is the criterion that decides whether an interface can be operated at all without sight.

50 distinct defects were identified, appearing 265 times across 36 pages.

Contrast (Minimum) — SC 1.4.3, Level AA

Text contrasts with its background by at least 4.5 to 1, or 3 to 1 for large text.

What this looks like in practice. Light grey body text on a white background — the single most common accessibility defect on the web.

Who is affected. People with low vision, ageing eyes or colour vision deficiency; everyone reading on a phone outdoors.

30 distinct defects were identified, appearing 80 times across 16 pages.

Non-text Content — SC 1.1.1, Level A

Every image, icon, chart and control that is not text carries a text alternative serving the same purpose, and anything purely decorative is marked so it can be skipped.

What this looks like in practice. A screen reader announces "IMG_4821.jpg" instead of what the picture shows, or reads out every decorative flourish as an unnamed graphic.

Who is affected. People who are blind or have low vision and rely on a screen reader; anyone on a slow connection where images fail to load; search and translation tools that read the page as text.

28 distinct defects were identified, appearing 99 times across 35 pages.

Info and Relationships — SC 1.3.1, Level A

Structure that is visible — headings, lists, tables, groups, labels — is also present in the markup, not created with styling alone.

What this looks like in practice. Bold larger text used as a heading with no heading element, so the screen reader's heading list is empty and the page cannot be skimmed.

Who is affected. Screen reader users, who navigate by that structure; people using reading tools, custom stylesheets or reflowed layouts.

26 distinct defects were identified, appearing 414 times across 36 pages.

Bypass Blocks — SC 2.4.1, Level A

There is a way to skip past content repeated on every page.

What this looks like in practice. No skip link and no landmark regions, so reaching the main content takes forty keystrokes each time.



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Who is affected. Keyboard and screen reader users, who would otherwise tab through the whole header and navigation on every single page.

11 distinct defects were identified, appearing 34 times across 20 pages.

Keyboard — SC 2.1.1, Level A

Everything that can be done with a mouse can be done from the keyboard.

What this looks like in practice. A menu or carousel that opens on hover or click but cannot be reached or operated with Tab and Enter.

Who is affected. People who cannot use a pointer — motor impairments, tremor, prosthetics — and every screen reader user, who drives the page from the keyboard.

4 distinct defects were identified, appearing 8 times across 7 pages.

Images of Text — SC 1.4.5, Level AA

Real text is used rather than pictures of text, unless the presentation is essential.

What this looks like in practice. A headline or a price table rendered as an image, which blurs when enlarged and cannot be read aloud.

Who is affected. People who enlarge text, change colours or fonts for dyslexia, or read with a screen reader.

3 distinct defects were identified, appearing 3 times across 1 page.

Meaningful Sequence — SC 1.3.2, Level A

When the order of content matters, the reading order in the markup matches the order it is meant to be read in.

What this looks like in practice. A two-column layout positioned with CSS so a screen reader reads the sidebar in the middle of a sentence.

Who is affected. Screen reader users and anyone navigating by keyboard, who receive content in source order rather than visual order.

2 distinct defects were identified, appearing 10 times across 5 pages.

Identify Input Purpose — SC 1.3.5, Level AA

Fields collecting the user's own details declare what they collect, so the browser can fill them.

What this looks like in practice. A name and address form with no autocomplete attributes, so nothing can be filled automatically.

Who is affected. People with motor impairments for whom every keystroke costs effort; people with cognitive or memory difficulties; anyone using autofill.

2 distinct defects were identified, appearing 10 times across 5 pages.

Non-text Contrast — SC 1.4.11, Level AA

The visual boundaries of controls, and the parts of graphics needed to understand them, contrast by at least 3 to 1.



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What this looks like in practice. A pale grey input border on white, or a chart whose series are distinguished by faint pastels.

Who is affected. People with low vision, who otherwise cannot find where a field or button begins and ends.

2 distinct defects were identified, appearing 2 times across 1 page.

Link Purpose (In Context) — SC 2.4.4, Level A

The purpose of each link is clear from its text, or from its text with its surrounding context.

What this looks like in practice. Twelve links all reading "Read more", indistinguishable in a link list.

Who is affected. Screen reader users, who often browse by pulling up a list of every link on the page with no surrounding text.

2 distinct defects were identified, appearing 2 times across 1 page.

Consistent Identification — SC 3.2.4, Level AA

Components with the same function are identified consistently.

What this looks like in practice. The same download control called "Download" on one page and "Get file" on the next.

Who is affected. Screen reader users and people with cognitive difficulties, who identify controls by name rather than by appearance.

1 distinct defect were identified, appearing 36 times across 36 pages.

Orientation — SC 1.3.4, Level AA

Content works in both portrait and landscape unless one orientation is essential.

What this looks like in practice. A page that forces portrait and shows "please rotate your device".

Who is affected. People whose device is fixed in one orientation — mounted to a wheelchair, a desk stand, or held in the only way they can hold it.

1 distinct defect were identified, appearing 4 times across 4 pages.

Label in Name — SC 2.5.3, Level A

The accessible name of a control contains the text shown on it.

What this looks like in practice. A button showing "Search" whose accessible name is "Submit query", so saying "click Search" does nothing.

Who is affected. Speech-input users, who say what they see — if the visible label and the accessible name differ, the command fails.

1 distinct defect were identified, appearing 1 time across 1 page.



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Reading these numbers

A defect is one thing to correct; a finding is one place it appears. A single component repeated across a site produces many findings and one defect, and one correction clears them all. The 912 findings recorded here resolve to 140 defects, which is the measure of the work.

Where a finding has been recorded against content falling within any of the exclusions above, it is reported as an observation for the Regulated Entity's information. Such observations carry no conformance claim, do not form part of the Status of Compliance stated in this report, and do not extend the scope of this audit to the excluded class.

Where remediation was concentrated

Remediation was concentrated on the 5 corrections below, which carry the most of this platform. The widest of them appears on 36 of the 37 pages evaluated. They were taken first not because they are the most numerous, but because each is one correction that clears every page it appears on.

"Who it unblocks" names the groups for whom the affected task cannot presently be completed at all, not those merely inconvenienced. Where a correction blocks nobody outright it is still required for conformance.

How this schedule is ordered

Remediation was sequenced by defect rather than by page. Where one defect appears on many pages it is a single correction that clears every page it touches, so the entries below are ordered by how much of the platform each correction addresses.



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Corrections that clear more than one page

65 of the 140 defects appear on more than one page. The largest are listed first.

A further 25 multi-page defects are carried in the findings register.

Verification

Each correction was verified by re-evaluating the pages on which the defect was recorded, against the same Success Criterion. A correction is treated as complete only where the criterion no longer records a finding on those pages.

SEBI Circular 131/2025 sets 31 July 2026 as the date by which regulated entities are to have completed remediation and filed. The measures set out above are those undertaken by the Regulated Entity during remediation. Where findings remain, the corrections still required are listed in the order in which they clear the most of the platform, and the schedule for completing them is the Regulated Entity's to set.

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Certificate of Conformance

WCAG 2.1 Level AA — Accessibility Conformance Report

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Statement of conformance

equitymidas.com conforms to WCAG 2.1 Level AA. Of the 50 Level A and Level AA Success Criteria, 41 are supported and 9 are not applicable to this platform. No criterion is unsupported.

This certificate is issued on the basis of an evaluation conducted over 37 pages of the site, the remediation undertaken by the Regulated Entity, and a re-verification run against the live site on 29 July 2026. 4 of the 50 criteria carry a basis of direct verification against the live page; the remainder rest on the evaluation record and, where a finding was recorded and remediated, on that remediation. The basis for each is stated individually, and no criterion is asserted on a stronger footing than the evidence behind it.

How to read the schedule

Each criterion carries a conformance verdict and the basis that verdict rests on. They are separate questions: two criteria can both read “Supports” on very different evidence.

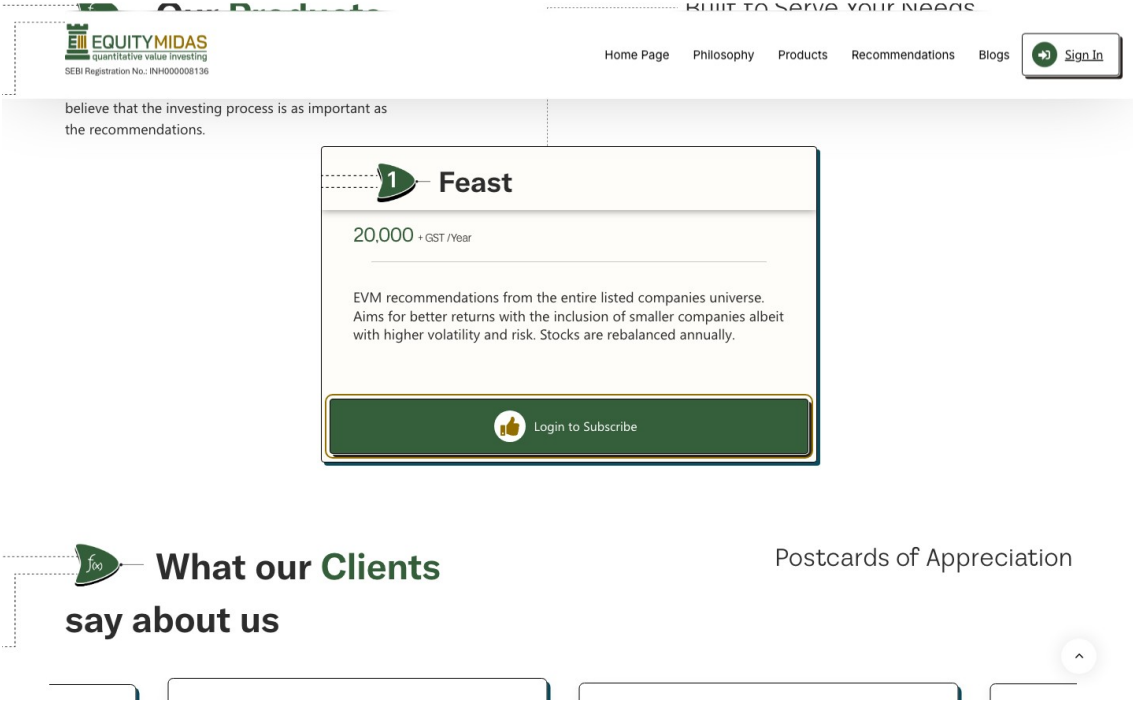
